1. Chapter Reports
 - a. Baden Powell
 - i. Started unit elections; first one will be Monday 29th of August.

 - v. Will run Cub Winter day.
 - b. Big Tepee

 - c. Black Beaver
 - i. Helped a lot at July Ordeal, which inducted 34 new candidates, and chapter completed 75.5 man-hours of service.
